Tango Networks Announces the First IMS Fixed-Mobile Convergence Application Designed for Enterprises

Tango Abrazo facilitates service convergence between enterprise and mobile operator networks

RICHARDSON, TX, JULY 11, 2007 — Tango Networks™ today introduced a significant enhancement to its Tango Abrazo™ fixed-mobile convergence solution, the addition of IMS (IP Multimedia Subsystem) functionality, enabling service providers to extend the power of IMS-based systems to the enterprise network.

This IMS solution, believed to be an industry first, builds upon the already available GSM and IS-41 offerings from Tango Networks. The IMS-enabled Tango Abrazo assures that providers can more effectively integrate their fixed-mobile service offerings with enterprise PBXs – whether legacy, hybrid or IP-based.

Mobile operators (both wireline and wireless) are evolving their network architectures to incorporate IMS standards, which are designed to facilitate and accelerate the deployment of feature-rich applications, across network boundaries and anywhere in the world.. To date, this capability has not crossed the boundary between carrier networks and enterprise networks, but the enhanced capabilities of the Tango Abrazo pave the way for that crossover.

Unlike other fixed-mobile convergence solutions that simply simulate the PBX, the Tango Abrazo actually extends true PBX features to the mobile phone, creating a seamless, feature-rich experience for the end user as it integrates mobile phones into the corporate enterprise. Tango's unique IMS-based hybrid architecture bridges the best of the mobile operator network with the best of the enterprise network. This seamless interconnection is on top of the Abrazo's powerful application programming interfaces (APIs) that allow enterprises to customize to their specific business requirements.

For the enterprise, this true integration delivers increased employee productivity, accessibility, and customer satisfaction. Tango Abrazo enhances a corporation's mobility policy and helps to control costs, while leveraging the current investments in PBX systems and handsets. The highly customizable Tango Abrazo solution is easily deployed and facilitates regulatory compliance.

For the mobile operator, the Abrazo increases revenue opportunities and leads to lower churn. The standardized solution shields operators from the complexities of the enterprise environment. By enabling Tango Abrazo in their networks, operators have an early mover advantage in offering compelling, high-value enterprise services.

Abrazo bridges the gap between legacy and next generation networks. The enhanced Abrazo solution is based on IMS, but is compatible with existing carrier network architectures, including IS41, WIN, GSM/MAP, and CAMEL. In addition, the Tango Abrazo supports, rather than dictates, enterprise movement to IP by including support for legacy, hybrid, and IP-PBXs.

“Enterprises have significant investments in IP telephony for their employee desk phones,” stated Alastair Westgarth, chief operating officer at Tango Networks. “The last thing these enterprises want is to see these IP-based desk phones become useless bookends. By integrating the desk phones with the mobile phones that have become so indispensable in this day and age, Tango Networks ensures that corporations continue to make great use of these essential tools, turning mobiles into highly valuable corporate assets as well.”
